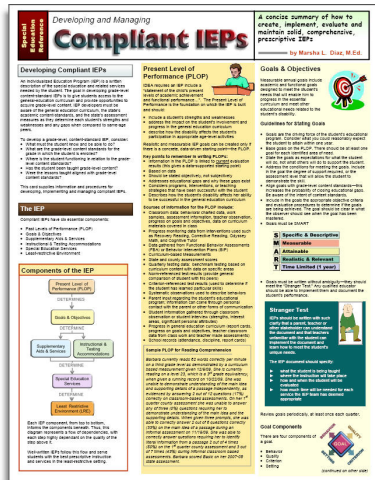


# Developing and Managing Compliant IEPs

### Least Restrictive Environment

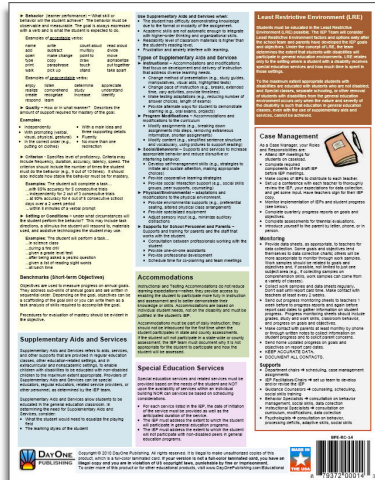
- ▶ based on goals & objectives ▶ where concept is applied.
